› #1 exporter of fruit in the Southern Hemisphere

Largest fresh fruit supplier of China and largest exporter of cherries, table grapes and plums in the world.

› Diversity, all year long!

Chile grows and exports over 30 species of fruit to the world from January to December. Our unique mediterranean climate allows us to supply the Northern Hemisphere off-season, because our winter is your summer!

› Unique natural barriers

Our fruit grows in a land at the end of the world, blessed by natural borders such as the Atacama Desert to the North, the Pacific Ocean to the West, the Andes mountains to the East and Patagonia ice fields to the south, turning Chile into a phytosanitary island!

Chilean Kiwifruit Committee

- The Kiwifruit Committee is an organization of Voluntary Participation. It was founded in 2009 by the joint effort of Growers, Exporters and their associations: **FEDEFruta** and **ASOEX**. We work together to improve the positioning of the Chilean Kiwifruit.
- It represents **55% of the national production** 70% of growers and exporters: 32 exporting company partners and 220 grower partners.



Assurance Maturity Program (PAM)

Nine years ago we started with the PAM program certifying harvested fruit with the minimum appropriate sugar level (maturity) and the appropriate ripeness.

Ripening Program (PM)

The PM program enables fruit to express its maximum consumption potential, ensuring a delicious and ripe Kiwifruit to the final consumer. A ripe kiwi increases the satisfaction of its consumption and increases repeat sales.

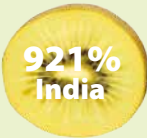
Chile in Far East



**Chile is No.1
in China,**
the largest fresh fruit
exporter to China (2019).

- Far East is an important market for Chile, which is expressed by the significant increase in Kiwifruit exports during seasons 2015 to 2019, where we **grew 59%**.
- **New navigation routes** have been set up reducing travelling times, allowing to arrive with an even **fresher fruit**.

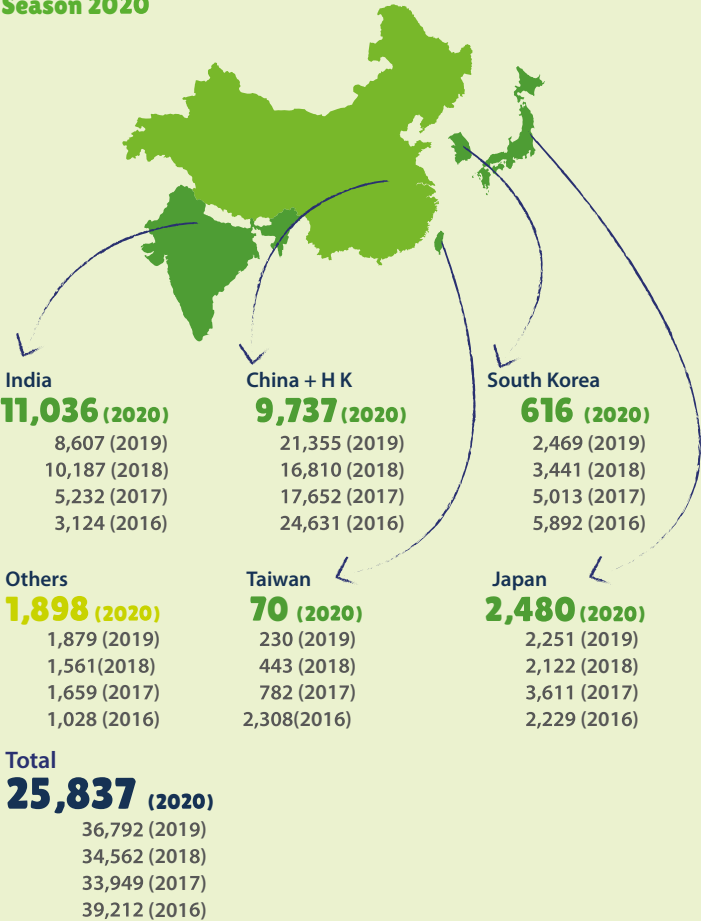
**Increase from 2015 to 2019

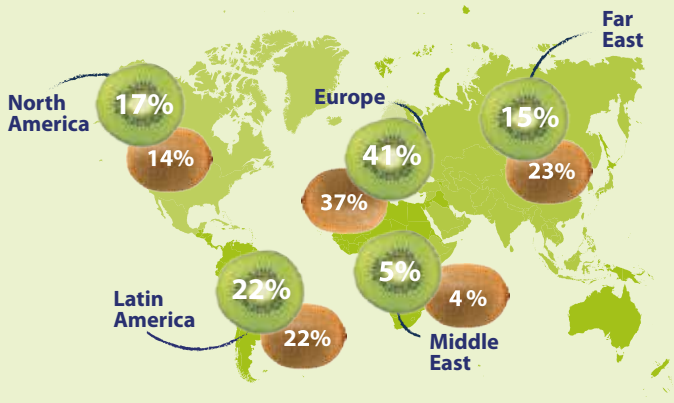
